Impact of corona virus (covid-19) on Fluvius's operations assessed

Fluvius System Operator CV ["Fluvius"] comments on the potential impact of the corona virus on the Fluvius Economic Group's operations and finances, and on the measures taken to safeguard operational continuity.

Operations

The Fluvius teams are continuing to safeguard the electricity and gas distribution, along with the Group's other activities, in Flanders. The Management Committee has decided to activate the existing Contingency & Business Continuity plans and these are implemented as foreseen. All employees have received concrete information on how they have to safely execute their tasks and to prevent the further spread of the virus as much as possible.

Management is closely monitoring the evolutions and will take the appropriate measures to further safeguard the service continuity with absolute priority for urgent and necessary interventions.

Possible financial impact

Fluvius draws the attention to the fact that the Group's core activities (i.e. the distribution of electricity and gas) take place within a regulated framework.

About Fluvius

Fluvius System Operator CV ("Fluvius") was created on 1 July 2018 by the merger of Eandis System Operator cvba and Infracx cvba. Fluvius and its affiliates (together the 'Fluvius Group' or the 'Group') is the independent multi-utility company that delivers operational services and public service obligations at cost price for eleven Flemish intermunicipal companies. Ten of these companies are distribution system operators for electricity and/or gas (Fluvius Antwerpen, Fluvius Limburg, Fluvius West, Gaselwest, Imewo, Intergem, Iveka, Iverlek, PBE and Sibelgas); the eleventh is the sewerage intermunicipality Riobra. Fluvius has operations in electricity, gas, public lighting, district heating, sewerage and cable TV infrastructure. The Group covers the entire Flemish Region. The Group and the intermunicipalities taken together constitute the Fluvius Economic Group. Fluvius is responsible for 7,3 million utility connections. The company employs 5.419 employees (31 December 2019).
